

8. All entries will be handled with care, but competition organisers cannot accept liability for loss or damage, however caused.
9. **The judges' decision will be final.** The judges reserve the right to abandon viewing an entry after 15 minutes, at their discretion.
10. **The Public Show** will include as many videos as possible. **Sometimes, because of time constraints, it is not physically possible to show every film entered.** Also organisers may choose to show extracts and to choose those entries best suited to make a balanced programme which is acceptable to the expected audience. If extracts are shown, the maker will be contacted for approval.

Please note, if the film entered is NOT suitable for a general audience, the organisers reserve the right not to show it.

11. On any matters not covered by these rules, the Kent Film Festival committee's decisions will be final.

Awards—Winners will receive a small trophy (if attending on the day) which they will keep, plus a certificate. Certificates of Merit may be awarded at judges discretion.

These awards are for those who have not received any professional help.

Kent Film Festival Rules

- An amateur video** is deemed to be one that is made exclusively for the joy and challenge of making it, with no profit motive involved and without **paid** creative or other professional assistance other than processing, grading, the physical process of sound transfer or video copying. A Student or Young Person who has accepted **paid** creative help from a professional must enter the open class.
- Entrants** must be resident, or attending a college or school within Kent or an SE London postcode area or be a member of a Film-Making Club in those areas. Makers are encouraged also to enter the SERIAC 2020 Festival (the next step after the County Festivals) which is run by the IAC's South East Region.
- Special entrant categories:**
Those under 17 years, Young Persons Award for those 17—21 years, The age cut-off date is the 31st August, based on academic year. All entrants should declare what assistance they received.
Student Open Entrants are those who have accepted paid professional assistance or are in higher education for a career in film/video making. They are not also eligible for under 17 or Young Person Award.
School/College Group entry - The credits must show at least **three** pupils names to indicate collaborative effort. The age of the oldest pupil defines the category. Entrant name can be either an individual or school/college name.
- Formats:**
The Festival accepts finalised DVD's as .VOB in Standard Definition. We also accept Blu-Ray and AVCHD disks. We may ask for a standard definition copy e.g. on a USB Stick, DVD or sent on line if the Blu-Ray or AVCHD disk is not compatible with viewing equipment.
We are accepting USB sticks with films in standard **H264 MP4** format or **.AVI** file for standard definition. No menus or other films on the stick. If problems exist with projection, we reserve the right to convert onto disk. Alternatively, send film via **WeTransfer**. More details on Entry Sheet opposite.
For DVD's, Blu-Ray and AVCHD, only the film entered to be on the disk with **10 seconds of black** at the beginning. The DVD, Blu-Ray or AVCHD disk must have a single start point and NO MENU.
Please note, DVD-RW and DVD-RAM disks are **not** acceptable. DVD's must be marked with title and format (Ratio/Aspect). We suggest they come with a protective sleeve.
USB sticks, films to have 10 seconds of black to allow loading and pausing before showing.
- Previous entries** to this competition will not be eligible unless they have been significantly worked on since then.
- Entering your movie:**
A completed and signed 2019 Entry Form (photocopies are acceptable) must accompany **each** movie. All competitors not collecting their entry from the Festival **must** provide £2 cash, or send a cheque made payable to the Kent Film Festival covering for return **postage**. Internet banking available, see front sheet of entry form for more details.
All entries must be received by the Competition Officer by the **24th July, 2019**.
Kent Film Festival entry fees this year for under 21 years are : **Free** . *Note, if a member of a club, you cannot use the club IAC number for your personal entries.*
- Any copyright** in picture and sound must be cleared by the entrant who takes absolute responsibility for this. This includes any pictures or sound recorded from broadcast or professional video sources.
